The scientific program for the 35th annual conference of the Urological Society of India - West Zone is ready. The program has been made with the intent of covering all the broad subspecialties and making it as interactive and visual as possible.

- Urethral reconstruction (graft harvesting and use techniques, staged urethroplasty techniques)
- Tricky situations in stone surgeries
- Transplant: donor retrieval, bench surgery and recipient surgery.
- 3. Interesting debates (4)
- 4. Clinical case based panel discussion with experts (12 sessions) in Urolithiasis, complications in transplantation, renal masses, prostate cancer, pediatric urology, LUTS and BPH in the elderly, GU tuberculosis, varicocele and OATS, consensus in controversies and intra-operative surgical complications.
- 5. Time for delegate interaction at the end of every session.
- 6. Opportunity to young and newer people on the stage.
- 7. Prize paper sessions: 18 podium, 18 videos and 70 posters (3 prizes in each category)
- 8. Quiz for postgraduates and a special quiz for delegates.
- 9. Building a successful urology career for young urologists with emphasis on digital presence and options of international fellowships.
- 10. Short talks (4-6min each) replacing lengthy lectures.

Having enlisted the highlights, the truth remains that no scientific meeting can be successful without a healthy delegate attendance and participation. We look forward to everyone's registration and participation in our annual academic event. We also look forward to your feedback and suggestions towards betterment of the scientific agenda every year.

- 4. Maximum number of slides per E-poster: 3 (besides the title slide)
- 5. The title slide should contain the title of your presentation along with the abstract number for the judges to mark your paper.
- 6. Author's name or name of institution should not be disclosed in the file name or in the presentation.
- 7. All slides should be in landscape format
- 8. Animation/movies/sounds will not be supported; please submit in a static PPT format only.
- 9. Design Specifications
- Each slide title should be placed in a title placeholder.
- The text should include (most likely as separate elements of the poster): Introduction, Aim, Methods, Results, Conclusion and Acknowledgements.
- 10. The poster should be self-explanatory. Text should be brief and well organized
- 11. Font specifications:
- It is suggested that font size of the text should be at least 26 to 36 point.
- The font chosen should be a simple and clear one (e.g. Helvetica).
- The correct font size depends greatly on the fonts used in the ppt and the thumb rule should be that if its visible well on the computer screen it shall be visible on the E-Poster Display Screen.
- Color suggestions: When using light backgrounds (white, yellow, light blue) we suggest using dark fonts (black, navy blue, dark green). When using dark backgrounds (blue, purple) we suggest using light fonts (white, yellow, cyan). Avoid using red or green in any fonts or backgrounds as they are colors that are difficult to read.


